Jurying Standard

CLASS: General for all Crafts

NCA Standards:

- 1. Each item must be handcrafted by the member and demonstrate the use of skills, which can only be achieved by specialized training and experience.
- 2. A significant transformation must be accomplished. This means that the member has started with a manufactured or cultured design as a base for the craft (i.e.: fabric, wreath forms, containers, wooden items, gems, glass) and has transformed this base, using a creative process (i.e.: painting, sewing, floral arranging) that changes the original appearance or intended use of the manufactured design.
- 3. Items must function as designed and be durable for their intended use.
- 4. Raw materials must be of good quality and suited for the intended use of the item.
- 5. Items must not be hazardous (e.g.: no jagged or sharp edges).
- 6. All items must have proper labeling.
- 7. All items must be in good taste and fit for family viewing (i.e.: not of a pornographic or offensive nature).
- 8. Patterns, transfers, molds and preformed assemblies (i.e.: clock movements) can only be used as subordinate parts of an item.
- 9. All mandatory NCA standards regarding your craft products must be followed.

The following are not permitted:

- 'piece work' items, that is any part of item constructed by someone other than the crafter,
- items produced from kits.
