Mandatory Standard

CLASS: Gourmet food and confectionaries

AUTHORITY

- Food retailers (e.g. Farmer's markets, craft shows) and Food service companies (e.g. bakeries, caterers, etc.) are governed by food safety rules in:
- *Food Premises Regulation* (Ontario Regulation 493/17) under the *Health Protection and Promotion Act*Food packaging and labelling is covered under:
- Consumer Packaging and Labelling Regulations under the Consumer Packaging and Labelling Act

COVERAGE

- Homemade foods that are not commercially prepared and prepackaged products (i.e.: individual hot chocolate mix, candy, etc.)
- Homemade food that is pre-packaged (i.e. packaged by vendor prior to market) or is offered for sale unpackaged and then packaged by a vendor at the request of a consumer (i.e. individual baked goods)
